BUILD YOUR OWN SAILBOAT

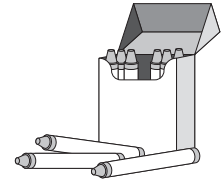

(can be printer paper or construction paper)

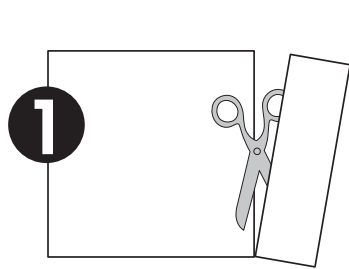


scissors
(always ask your parents for help before using)

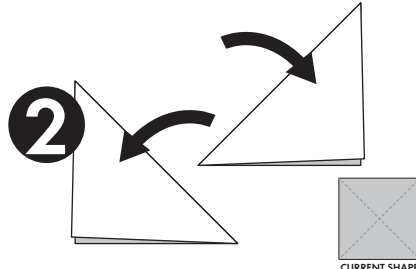


markers, pencils or crayons
(or anything else you want to use to decorate your sailboat)

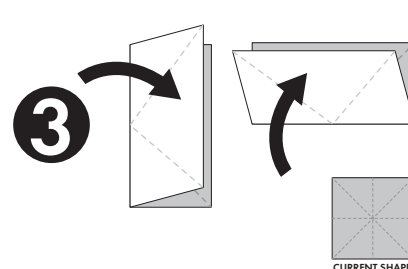
WHAT YOU'LL NEED:



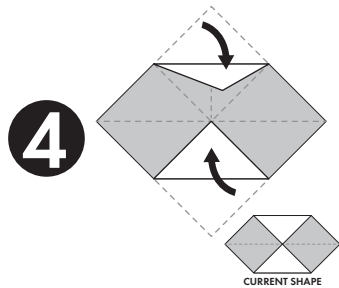
1 Cut your paper into a square. Measure 2.5" from one end and cut to 8.5" x 8.5"



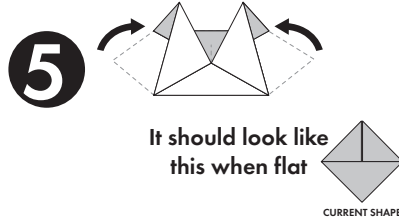
2 Fold the paper in half by bringing one corner down to the opposite corner. Then repeat for the other side. Unfold the paper and it should have fold lines as shown.



3 Now fold your paper in half as shown. Fold it left to right, then fold it top to bottom. Unfold the paper and it should have fold lines as shown.

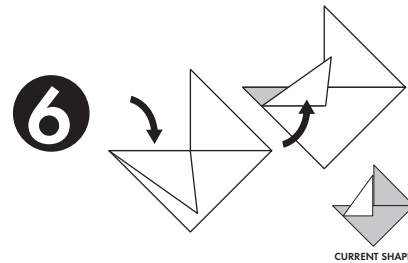


4 Turn the paper so it forms a diamond shape on the table. Fold the top and bottom pieces as shown.

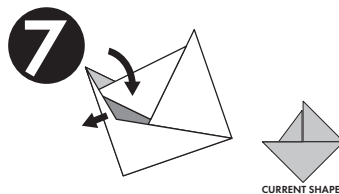

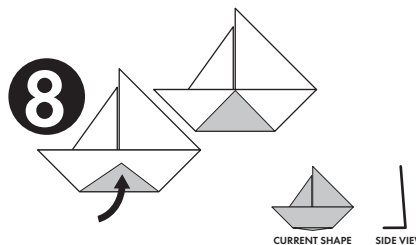
It should look like this when flat



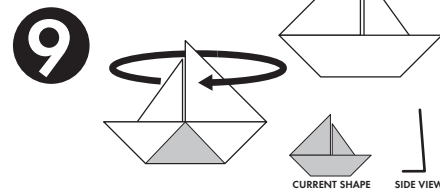
6 Grab the left side and fold it down even with the bottom edge. Then fold it back up about a quarter of an inch.



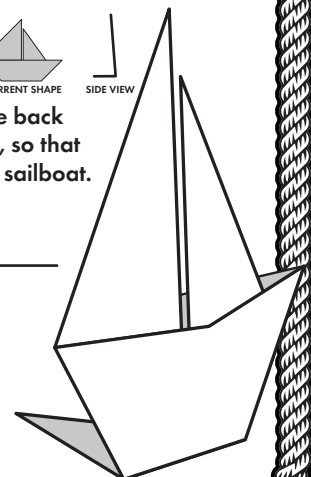
7 Pull the bottom flap toward you and tuck the folded section inside the flap.



8 Now grab the bottom and fold it up so that the point meets the centerline, then crease it and fold it back 90 degrees.



9 Flip it around and fold the back flap half way back down, so that it makes a stand for your sailboat.



You're Done. Great Job!
